It is good to diversify across asset classes:



- No single asset class returns the highest returns or close to it each year. The returns reflected are those of indices for each asset class.
- Investing across asset classes produces returns in the top five in most years.
 The returns you could earn from investing across asset classes are shown here by way of a multi-asset index made up of the indices for the other asset classes.
